Use of the Playground Before and After School

The head teacher is responsible for implementing and monitoring the Governing Body's health and safety policies and procedures.

The current policy is that unaccompanied children should not play in the school grounds (which includes on the playground and the climbing frame) before school or after 3.20pm. This is because there is no member of staff outside to supervise them. Children who are accompanied by parents are the responsibility of the accompanying parents and we ask that these parents supervise their own children before 8.40am. If the bus children do arrive before the doors are unlocked at 8.40am, they should come to the main entrance of the school.

Parents have expressed concern that children are not allowed to play unsupervised in the playground before the start of the school day and this concern has been relayed to the governor responsible for health and safety. While we sympathise with the feeling that this is 'health and safety gone mad' any decision regarding changing the current policy rests with the governors.
